Fund objective and policy

The Fund seeks to provide growth, combining capital and income over the long term, consistent with a growth risk profile. It seeks to address sustainability challenges facing people and the environment by investing in issuers whose products, services or investments provide solutions aligned to its "Sustainability Themes": e.g. Energy transition, Resource efficiency, Sustainable infrastructure. The Fund gains exposure to a range of global asset classes, but at least 70% is invested in company shares, or bonds. Typically, 40-80% is held in shares, in keeping with a growth risk profile. We assess and select investments using Columbia Threadneedle's Standard of Sustainability, to ensure issuers' solutions align to the Stainability Themes and are material e.g. a business driver. We exclude issuers whose activities are harmful to the environment or society e.g. those with significant exposure to weapons, tobacco, coal, oil and gas. The Fund does not invest in issuers breaching international standards.


